




Around **25.8 million** tons of plastic waste are generated in Europe every year.

Lost to the economy after a very short first-use cycle (between EUR 70 and 105 billion annually).


In 2017, the EU take decision on ensuring that all plastic packaging is recyclable by 2030.

Environmental Kuznets curve (Simon Kuznets, 1960)


Morality, ethics and social responsibility should not be excluded from shareholders' goal



Triple bottom line (TBL)



- ☐ Help to create a dynamic knowledge-based society












How could university incorporate Green Concept?



Demand and Supply of skilled manpower

Businesses that are sustainable will dominate the markets in the future.

Can offer several course e.g., Green Business, Circular Economy, CSR, Environmental economics, Green Marketing, Environmental law ...

- These courses should include how firms integrate sustainability in their business foundation in wider context.
- The course aims on giving students competences and analytical tools to take on this challenge as managers as well as drawing an overall picture on the sustainability and responsibility discourse.

So, the student:

- ☐ Gains knowledge of sustainability issues and their relationship to business.
- Acquire skills in analysis of business situations and developing recommendations that includes consideration of the environmental and social responsibility implications as well as the completeness of business.
- ☐ Acquire skills in use of analytical tools for assessing specific sustainability-related issues for business.

University-Business Cooperation (UBC)

This is a **relationship**, which encourages the process of exchanging knowledge **among** educational institutions and industry, therefore, to support **universities** in developing learning activities and offer **businesses** opportunities to foster innovations (European Commission 2014).
